President's Message

Dear Carrolltowne Community,

This message is a diversion from my normal recognition of all the PTA has done in the past month. Instead, I'm issuing a call to action to all our parents.

In 2021, the Blueprint for Maryland's Future was voted into law, a comprehensive plan to improve public education for all children in the state through five pillars:

- 1. Early Childhood Education
- 2. High-Quality and Diverse Teachers and Leaders
- 3. College and Career Readiness
- 4. More Resources to Ensure That All Students Are Successful
- 5. Governance and Accountability

Though we all want our children to have access to these pillars, at this time, there will be a budgetary shortfall in our schools, beginning next school year, to implement this law unless we, as stewards of our children's education, get involved.

The official National PTA slogan is "Every child, one voice." An important mission for all PTAs is to advocate for every child's education. This means becoming informed of the policies affecting our schools and then taking action to ensure our kids have access to the high-quality education we've all come to rely on.

I'm asking you to exercise your rights to have a say in the outcome of your child's public schooling by:

- 1. Reading up on the Blueprint for Maryland's Future at https://blueprint.marylandpublicschools.org/
- 2. Attending Superintendent Cindy McCabe's town hall on April 19 at 6:00 p.m. at Winter's Mill High School to learn more and ask questions
- 3. Writing our county commissioners asking them to fully fund CCPS's proposed budget

 - * Delegate Eric Bouchat (christopher.bouchat@house.state.md.us)

 - * Delegate Chris Tomlinson (chris.tomlinson@house.state.md.us)
- 5. Attending the Proposed Budget Community Presentation on April 26 at 7:00 p.m. at Eldersburg Library
- 6. Attending the Budget Public Hearing on May 9 at 7:00 p.m. at Carroll Community College's Scott Center

This may seem like a lengthy list, but I assure you that informing yourself about these policies and voicing your opinions to those who have the power to act on them will be well worth it. Our schools' budgets for next school year will be decided on May 23. After that time, it will be too late to act.



It's so important to be aware of the intention and how the process will effect us here in Carroll County. The first was Monday 3/20 at 6pm at Century High School. The second one will be Wednesday, 4/19 at 6pm at Winters Mill High School.

If you are unable to attend either of the town hall meetings, here are a few things that you can still do to help our school system:

Write to Our Delegates!

Ask them to 1) loosen the restrictive nature of education funding,
2) recalculate the formula for education funding, and/or
3) grant waivers to districts that are struggling financially to implement parts of the Blueprint.


Write to Our Commissioners!




