Your assignment: Please educate yourself on the implications of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future on Carroll County Public Schools, particularly as it will affect Carrolltowne, ORMS, and Liberty, the schools our children will attend for the duration of their public education careers. Blueprint aims to improve public education, and it will take resources to accomplish its goals. It is imperative to us all to find out what that means for our kids.

If you feel so inclined, I strongly encourage you to reach out to our commissioners before their budget hearing on May 9, 2023, and urge them to consider how the county's budget will affect not just our children's schools but also our property values and our way of life. 



Template Letter to Commissioners

Dear Commissioner Rothstein, Commissioner Kiler, Commissioner Gordon, Commissioner Guerin, and Commissioner Vigliotti,

I am a parent whose child attends Carrolltowne Elementary School, and I urge you to fully fund education in Carroll County for FY2023–2024, particularly in the face of the budgetary shortfall that will occur in implementing the mandated Blueprint for Maryland's Future.

To comply with state law, CCPS has determined that the budget it has operated with in the past will be insufficient to maintain public education in Carroll County as we know it. Resources will be shifted from our schools to meet the requirements of Blueprint, and based on recent state aid documents, it appears that at least one-fifth of what we currently consider nonrestricted state and local combined funding will be repurposed and will result in an estimated budget deficit of \$26,500 for this year alone.

It is also my understanding that over the past several years, CCPS has experienced substantial budget cuts, resulting in a tremendous loss of staff, difficulties maintaining our facilities, and the inability to pay for resources necessary for our children's success. They are operating with a bare-bones budget that is not sustainable this year or in subsequent years.

Carroll County's children and their education deserve to be prioritized. The exceptional schools are what bring many of us to this county and keep us here. It contributes significantly to the values of our homes and our way of life. This county cannot afford to shortchange our children's futures.

I implore you do everything you can to protect our children's education, our property values, and our beautiful county we call home by fully funding Carroll County Public Schools now and in the future. I look forward to hearing from you on this matter, so please contact me at your earliest convenience.


