#### **President's Message**

**Hello Carrolltowne Community,** 

We've had a busy fall here at Carrolltowne and it's been so much fun to see! We had a very successful Fun Run, a fantastic Trunk or Treat, a great Cultural Arts Assembly, and several successful restaurant night fundraisers. The PTA will keep things going throughout the holiday season with our upcoming Holiday Shop, more restaurant nights, and Finding Nemo Jr. rehearsals starting.

We are continuing to raise money for the poured rubber surfacing for the playground. As I said in my remarks in October, we did give the school a check for \$120, 000 and the equipment has been ordered for the new playground. The focus now is the poured rubber surfacing which increases accessibility for all students. It is a big goal (we still need to raise \$77, 000) but I am hoping we can make a significant dent in that amount over the next few months. Our next PTA meeting is February 8, 2024 at 7 pm in the media center. I encourage all members of the Carrolltowne community to attend. Upcoming PTA events are discussed and significant budgetary items are reviewed and discussed – i.e. funding for the playground. If you have any questions about how the PTA is spending its funds, including how we are funding the playground, please come to the meetings. We vote regularly on these budgetary measures. If you want a say in how we spend the PTA money (money that you help raise!) please attend the meeting. You must be a member of the PTA to vote, so sign up today!

Thank you all for your support so far this year; it's been a busy but exciting first quarter, and I am looking forward to what the rest of the year will bring.

For the 2022-2023 school year the PTA's main priority was to raise funds for a new playground. The goal for a playground with mulch:

\$172,000

The initial goal was met, and exceeded!!



We funraised:

\$120,000

By advocating to our elected officials, we secured public funding :

\$75,000



We have already secured a contractor and ordered the playground equipment in the original estimate. A check for the \$120K has already been issued to the school.



Installation will begin spring 2024\* subject to weather and vendor timeline.



For \$100K more than the original contract, we can have poured rubber installed instead of mulch. Because we exceeded the mulch playground estimate, we already have \$23,000 towards this increase.

Fundraising Goal for 2023-2024 School Year:

\$77,000\*

\*If the total \$77K is not raised we can still purchase partial sq ft with the collected funds





#### Why Poured Rubber?

- A poured rubber surface would ensure ALL of our CES students are able to access and enjoy our new playground. A more inclusive playground only enhances our students' daily lives and brings our community together.
- Poured rubber drains faster than dirt increasing the number of outside recess days.
- Poured rubber is lower maintenance than mulch, which needs to be refilled every year, and lasts an average of 10 years.
- Poured rubber increases the overall safety of the play area because of an even surface and impact absorption.



Please continue to support Carrolltowne's fundraising effort. Participating in our upcoming fundraising events only brings us closer to our new goal to purchase poured rubber for our new playground. Be on the lookout for more information on upcoming spirit nights, the Winter Carnival, Tristar fundraiser, and other ways to contribute.
