President's Message

Dear Carrolltowne Families -

Happy October! I hope everyone is able to take advantage of this beautiful fall weather we have been having lately – enjoy that sunshine while you can! Here at the PTA, we are gearing up for the PTA "busy season" between Trunk or Treat, the Fun Run, Holiday Shop, and the start of the play.

The Fun Run will be November 7 (rain date November 8.) This is our biggest fundraiser of the year and we need the support of as many Carrolltowne families as possible so that we can continue to fund the PTA events that everyone has come to expect from the PTA. Even though we are no longer actively fundraising for a playground, our typical PTA activities require funding. For example, last week the PTA provided dinner for the teachers before the first round of parent teacher conferences, we have already scheduled the mobile Science Lab for the spring for the school, and we helped offset the cost of the first grade field trip to Toby's in Columbia to see Winnie the Pooh. We also pay for the school's BrainPop subscription, we are buying new projectors for various classrooms, and we are offering a Veteran's Day Breakfast for veterans on November 11. We cannot do all these of these activities without the support of the Carrolltowne community through fundraising – from the restaurant nights fundraisers to the Fun Run. We know everyone wants the community events and school support to continue – so please come out to support our students at the Fun Run and sign up on mybooster.com to raise pledges! Every penny raised helps reach our goal.

We also have two fundraisers running through the end of October – our fall Bupperts fundraiser and our Red Barn Ranch fundraiser. These are perfect opportunities to support Carrolltowne while also enjoying your favorite fall activities, from pumpkin picking to a haunted trail!






