

Sample Letter/Email

Dear [Senator Ferguson, Speaker Jones, Senator Feldman, and Delegate Atterbeary],

I am writing as a concerned Carroll County resident regarding the dire budget outlook for Carroll County Public Schools (CCPS) and the urgent need for flexibility in the Maryland Blueprint funding formulas. As it stands, CCPS is facing devastating budget shortfalls that could result in the elimination of 100 staff positions, leaving schools without media specialists, reading specialists, math specialists, and athletic directors. Additionally, elementary class sizes could reach 44 students, severely impacting the quality of education.

While we fully support the goals of the Blueprint for Maryland's Future, the rigid funding structure places an overwhelming financial burden on counties like ours. Without adjustments to funding requirements or increased state support, CCPS will be forced to make cuts that directly undermine the Blueprint's mission of providing high-quality education.

We urge you to advocate for greater flexibility in the funding formulas to prevent these drastic measures and ensure that all Maryland students—regardless of their county—receive the support they need to succeed. I appreciate your time and look forward to your response on how we can work together to address this crisis.

Please support these changes in House Bill 504.
